## Instinct Lesson #4

Instinct...many images come to mind; Jiminy Cricket, the cartoon with the angel on one shoulder, devil on the other. In this setting the perfect image is presented by our Guardian Angel. "...be at my side, to light, to guide, to rule, and to guard." This lesson offers an opportunity to introduce to the children the idea of this ever-present agent of God's loving care.

Younger children especially will relate well to personifying their angel. They can be invited to draw a picture of their guardian and name them, for example.

The children are likely still open to their own 'gut reaction' about people and situations. This is the focus of the lesson. 'That little voice' which warns us when we are not doing what we should and congratulates us when we are is there; we just need to listen for it.
