I, the undersigned Petitioner, _____ request

grounds which will be determined by the Tribunal of the Diocese of Camden according to the norms of Church Law.

Concerning the Respondent

I understand that according to Church Law, my request for a Declaration of Nullity cannot be considered unless my former spouse is contacted and offered the opportunity to testify. I agree to make every effort to locate my former spouse for the purpose of participating in the process. This effort includes, but is not limited to, previous known addresses, securing the social security number to assist in locating my former spouse should previous addresses prove useless, and performing an internet search for my former spouse in areas of probable residence.

Concerning the Witnesses

I understand that witnesses are necessary in order to authenticate my testimony and validate my basis for an annulment.

I agree to make every effort to present complete information regarding witnesses requested by the Tribunal and to elicit their cooperation when necessary. This includes their complete legal names, current addresses, telephone numbers and my relationship to them.

Concerning the Expenses

I understand that one does not pay for an annulment and that the fee requested is to assist in covering the cost of office procedures, most of which is covered by the Diocese.

I agree to pay a portion of the expenses incurred in my case. In addition to the Filing Fee of \$100.00, I agree to pay the remaining amount of \$700.00 in two stages:

\$ 400.00 will be required at the time of the Petitioner's interview.

\$ 300.00 will be required before the case is put on the docket for a decision.

I understand that these non-refundable monies (\$800.00) are not payment for an annulment which, in accordance with Canon Law, will be judged solely on the basis of grounds and sufficient proof from witnesses, but for the expenses of the annulment process which I will incur regardless of the outcome of the case.

There is an additional fee if a psychological evaluation is needed. Should an appeal of the decision be made to the Roman Rota, there is an additional fee of \$850.00 which will be required from the party which is making the appeal to Rome, in addition to a \$200 preparation fee.

Concerning Plans for a Future Marriage

I, the undersigned Petitioner, have initialed to show that I have read and understood the following points with regard to my petition for an annulment in my marriage:

- _____ 2. That no assurance can be given as to a definite time for the Completion of the annulment process which averages **eighteen (18) to twenty-four (24) months.**

- _____ 4. That if I, or my present civil spouse, should be participating in a Parish RCIA program, no assurance can be given that my case will be decided favorably in time for Baptism/Reception into the Church.
- _____ 5. That if the circumstances causing the invalidity of the marriage may so indicate, the Tribunal may require that I seek professional counseling or special Pre-Cana instruction before a marriage in the Catholic Church can be permitted.
- _____ 6. **ALL EVIDENCE PROVIDED TO THE TRIBUNAL IS TREATED CONFIDENTIALLY, BUT, IS NOT SECRET, CONFSSIONAL, OR COVERED UNDER HIPAA REGULATIONS.**
